## Middle School 1, Middle School 2 and High School Camps:

**Check-in:** Registration is 11:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. Program begins with lunch at 12:30 p.m.  
**Check-out:** Program ends with a Closing Ceremony in the Gym 10:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m.  
(sack lunch provided for all camp attendees)

## Challenge, Prospector and Tenderfoot Camps:

**Check-in:** Registration is 3:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m. on the first day of camp.  
**Check-out:** Campers must be picked up by 10:00 a.m. on the last day of camp.
