CLIMATE: The elevation at Camp Como is 10,125 feet so dressing in layers is a must as the weather can change rapidly. Altitude sickness can usually be avoided by staying **very** hydrated and avoiding salty foods.

GROCERY/FUEL: Fairplay has a small grocery store as well as three gas station/convenience stores.

WI-FI: While there is no Wi-Fi, you may be able to find areas of signal around the camp.
