## GOD IS A MATHEMATICIAN!

Jesus illustrates his love for math and multiplication in the parable of the talents. His response to the men that multiplied what was given to them was, *"Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things. Come and share your master's happiness."* (Mt 25:14-30)
