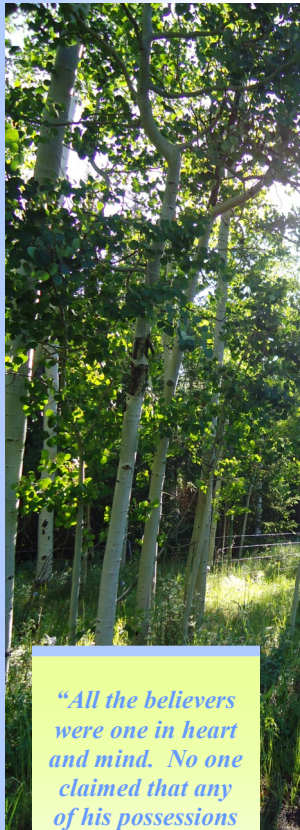
More than ever, we need your help. Finances are tight and camper numbers are up. Government agencies and insurance companies, along with other variables, are making it more complicated to operate.
